Westbury House is a **residential care home** set in the coastal town of Deal, Kent. We provide **high-quality support for up to 10 people** with autism, cerebral palsy, Down's syndrome, learning and physical disabilities and mental health needs.

Our friendly team provides **personalised 1:1 and 2:1 support** for individuals, help with personal care, accessing the local community and much more!

We regularly organise enjoyable **activities, entertainment, and day-trips**. These include visits to Deal Castle, Walmer Castle and the local sports centre.

Our home is within walking distance of the town centre and close to public transport links, **ideal for those wanting to explore the local shops or visit the beach**.





A place to call home

Our **spacious, detached home** features three bedrooms on the ground floor, with the remaining rooms on the first floor. Each bedroom has a wash basin for personal care. There are two wet rooms on the ground and first floor, alongside additional shared bathrooms.

We have lots of **shared communal areas**, including two lounges, a dining room and kitchen – perfect for the people we support to learn independent living skills. Our home is comfortable and easily accessible, with a **lift and ramps for wheelchair users**.

At the rear of the property, we have two gardens. One space is being developed to **encourage wildlife**, and the other has a lovely patio area where the people we support can engage in activities and parties!

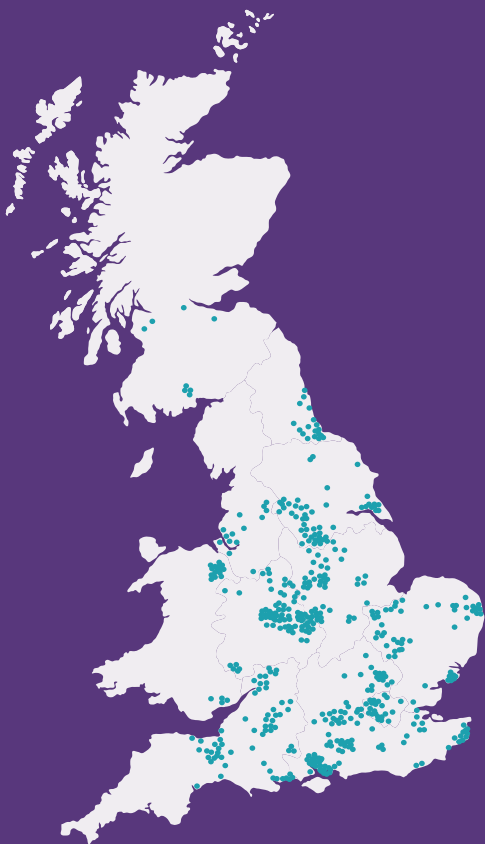
